WHAT: On the eve of the Vincent Chin 40th Remembrance & Rededication,

organizers will officially launch the 4-days of events and a commissioned commemorative mural of Vincent Chin by the artist Anthony L. Lee in Detroit's historic Chinatown. They will discuss activities planned to mark 40 years since the beating death of Vincent Chin by two white men who never served a single day in jail for the horrific hate crime.
